## PARENT AUTHORIZATION FOR STUDENT TO MAKE OUT-OF-DISTRICT TRIPS

Before participating in a school-sponsored trip outside the District or in school-sponsored extracurricular activities, students shall either have purchased the basic student accident insurance or shall present a waiver, signed by the parent or guardian, acknowledging rejection of the insurance offer and accepting full responsibility for medical costs of any injury that may result [FFD(Local)].

Students who represent the Lubbock Independent School District on out-of-town trips are expected to maintain very high standards in every respect at all times. They are expected to attend and be on time for all sessions and activities scheduled for them. In the event of overnight trips, they are expected to be in their rooms at the designated times by their sponsors.

Each student will be responsible to one or more faculty sponsors who will supervise the activities of the student for the trip. Negligence in attending sessions, in meeting curfew requirements, or in failing to maintain our standards of conduct may make it necessary for the sponsor to send the student home at his/her own expense.

Student conduct on school-related trips: Self-discipline is the key element for a pleasant experience for both the sponsor and the student when the student is on a school-related trip. Students who are involved in a serious disciplinary offense on a school-related trip, such as the use, possession of, or being under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol; stealing fighting, going to the room of a member of the opposite sex, or some other serious offense will face serious disciplinary action which may include one or more of the following:

- 1. The student will be sent home from the trip at the parents' expense.
- 2. The student will be held liable for damages to property.
- 3. The student may be removed from this school activity as well as other school co-curricular activities.
- 4. The student may be placed on in-school suspension from one to ten days.
- 5. The student may be referred to the Project Intercept Committee for possible placement at Project Intercept or expulsion from school for the remainder of the semester.
