

Local and County Stock show Instructions - Pigs

Schedule:

Thursday Jan 7 – be at the ag farm by 5:00PM to help set up the show ring.

Saturday Jan 9 – 2:00PM We are going to have another mini showmanship clinic at the ag farm if you need some extra help.

Sunday Jan 10 – Have all stock show donations to Mrs. Sanders so she can set up the sale list. I have only had 2 items donated so far from CHS students. **GET ON THE BALL!!! GET STUFF DONATED!!!**

MORE STUFF = MORE MONEY FOR YOU

Tuesday, Jan 12 – Local Stock show. LISD Ag farm pavilion begins at 6:00PM with Rabbits, then will be sheep and goats, the product auction, followed by pigs. Please stay until the product auction is over. People are bidding money on these items and this money will come back to you. Pigs will be moved to the Pavilion on Monday Jan 11th. This means that you will have to haul water to your pig 2-3 times a day minimum. Pigs that are not going to the county show will be moved back to their pens on Wednesday. If they are going to county, they will stay in the pavilion until we move them on Thursday.

I am going to try to clip pigs on Tuesday (**NO PROMISES**) depends on how smoothly everything runs. if they don't get clipped (hair cut) before local, it's not a big deal. Monterey is not going to clip any of their pigs for local. They will for sure be clipped before county.

Items you will want- (Bring these same items on Saturday as well)

- pig Whip
- bring the old towel (Freshly laundered) that we used to wash (for cleaning them off) I emphasize **OLD** it will be filthy!
- dawn soap or GoJO soap(if you need to wash again)
- feed for your pig
- feed trough
- Brush
- spray water bottle
